



Orange County Water District Social Media Code of Conduct August 30, 2016

Orange County Water District (the District) provides an opportunity for sharing and discussing information about its programs and activities through social media channels. You are encouraged to share your comments, ideas, and concerns. The District monitors and moderates its social media sites. Unacceptable content will be removed, and repeat individual violators may be banned from posting. Unacceptable content includes posts that threaten or defame any person or organization; contain obscene language or sexual content; promote or perpetuate discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regards to public assistance, national origin, disability, or sexual orientation; violate the legal ownership interest of another party; contain information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems; support or oppose political candidates or ballot propositions; promote illegal activity; promote commercial services or products; or are not topically related to the particular posting. A comment posted by a member of the public is the opinion of the commentator only, and publication of a comment does not imply endorsement of, or agreement by, the District, nor do such comments necessarily reflect the opinions or policies of the District. The District's social media sites are subject to the California Public Records Act. Any content maintained in a social media format that is related to the District's business, including a list of subscribers, posted communication, and communication submitted for posting, may be a public record subject to public disclosure. By interacting with the District through social media channels you agree to be bound by these terms.
